# Go directly through co-op for fastest, easiest paying

NAEC wants members to be aware of possible drawbacks to using third-party payment services.

Some third-party payment services, such as doxo, charge their users a fee. This is unlike NAEC's payment options that are all offered at no cost.

Also, some third-party payment services mail NAEC a check for the electric bill once a user pays them rather than using a direct payment method. Depending on when the payment is processed, this can lead to payments not being received at NAEC by the due date.

NAEC offers several payment options for our members. The most convenient is automatic bank draft. Enrolling in this free service ensures the bill is paid on time each month and eliminates the cost of a stamp. It also gives peace of mind to those away from home for an extended period of time.

Automatic bank draft is an electronic transfer from a member's bank account to NAEC's each month. With a member's permis-

sion, the bank will deduct the amount of the electric bill each month from the member's checking or savings account.

The member will continue to receive an itemized statement of the bill each month. On or about the 10th of every month, the amount of the bill will be deducted from the member's account. This payment method continues unless a member requests it be stopped, and the member does not have to worry about an expiration date, such as with a recurring credit or debit card payment.

To enroll in automatic bank draft, please visit a co-op office in Ash Flat, Mountain Home or Salem or sign up through the Member Account Portal at www.naeci.com. Other payment methods include:
